*Fort Huachuca, Arizona, July 1964, for low level recon tests and competition, Air Force, Marines and Navy took part along with a couple of civilian aircraft. I was Crew Chief on the Battalion commander's OV-1 for a while during this period, and the aircraft was either a converted dual control B model or an early C model with dual controls. (This was not the aircraft). I remember he was determined to have the G.E. mini guns under the wings and not any recon junk. I even tried a pair of 20 mm cannon pods at one time. Once General Kinnurd saw them on the plane I had to take them off and give them back to the F-4 that they had been borrowed from. I have never seen another photo showing the 11th air assault insionia on the tail of an OV-1*
