**From CAM – Coordinated Assistance Ministries, Inc.
Latest News**

From July 1st to September 30, 2016, CAM, Inc. served 271 people. This is 82 men, 91 women, 11 teens and 87 children. This number is unduplicated.

62 households reported being homeless. This report is at sign-in as “homeless” and is per the Client. As you know, everyone’s definition of homeless is different, including the government. Our count includes “couch-surfers”, those being evicted, and such, without a permanent address.

CAM housed 64 people in this third quarter – 48 adults, 12 children and 4 teens. All Clients housed come to us as homeless. We served 77 payee households this quarter.

In this quarter, with the tornado, CAM, Inc. received a call from Granpa Crachet (Sam Bowman) wishing to raise money to help poor children and families in the tornado through CAM. From this, CAM has been honored to be an agency of assistance to families in Garden Square Apartments – those without insurance and cash flow to replace what was lost in the disaster. With referrals through Red Cross and United Way Relief, I have personally visited in 32 homes.

The Howard County Ministerial Association, with Huddle, Psalms Bible Study, Revive Indiana, The Great Banquet, and The Wednesday Pastor’s Prayer Group have been working to invite the community to join in a Thanksgiving Service, Tuesday before Thanksgiving, 6 p.m. at New Beginnings Church, with Pastor Jeff Newton bringing the message, to celebrate coming through the Storm.
