


DiscoverE Camps

Pennsylvania State Parks' DiscoverE camp series is designed to help children learn about the world around them. These active environmental education programs allow children to explore the natural world with others of the same age.

Please keep in mind your child's abilities when deciding whether he/she will be comfortable in this learning experience. Instructors cannot provide extensive individual attention while working with their group. Group size is 10 for Hide-N-Seekers, 16 for Outdoor Explorers, and 16 for Penn's Adventurers.

More Information...

Summer day camps at Kings Gap have been developed over many years to meet the educational, developmental, and social skills typical of each age group. The programs are conducted outdoors and are designed to guide children to greater enjoyment, awareness, and knowledge of the natural world. Activities alternate between sedentary and active learning, with breaks as needed.

Children who progress from one level to another will continually grow in their understanding of the environment and their role in it. Campers are encouraged to explore their surroundings through guided experiences and nature play. Let nature become a part of your child's life.

Every attempt is made to provide a safe and enjoyable experience for participants; however, natural areas may possess hazards. First aid certified staff members are available in case of emergency.

Minimum requirements for camp:

- Able to use the restroom without help
- Age appropriate as of the first day of camp
- Able to enjoy camp without a parent
- Willing to get dirty/wet

Parents are asked to allow their children to experience DiscoverE camp on their own and without parental supervision. This allows your child to freely experience nature without distraction, socialize with children their own age, and gain a sense of independence.



Hide-N-Seekers (Ages 4-5)

Hide-N-Seekers includes hands-on outdoor explorations that stimulate environmental awareness within each child.

The activities have been designed to meet developmental levels of this age group, with an emphasis on sensory experiences and observation of the natural world.

Children who complete this program receive a certificate, ribbon, and badge.

This year's theme: Creatures Big and Small

Explore the differences between wild and domestic animals.

Choose one camp session:

- Camp 1 June 19-21 9:00 AM-11:00 AM
- Camp 2 July 10-12 9:00 AM-11:00 AM
- Camp 3 August 7-9 9:00 AM-11:00 AM

Fee: \$25

Outdoor Explorers (Ages 6-8)

Outdoor Explorers increase their awareness while gaining factual knowledge of the natural world through hands-on activities.

Children who complete this program receive a certificate, ribbon, and badge.

This year's theme: Feathers and Fur

Examine the characteristics of birds and mammals to learn how these adaptations help them survive.

Choose one camp session:

- Camp 4 June 19-21 9:00 AM-11:00 AM
- Camp 5 July 10-12 9:00 AM-11:00 AM
- Camp 6 July 24-26 9:00 AM-11:00 AM
- Camp 7 August 7-9 9:00 AM-11:00 AM

Fee: \$25

Penn's Adventurers (Ages 9-12)

Penn's Adventurers is a structured approach, guiding children to develop knowledge and problem-solving skills.

This camp provides hiking and more in-depth activities, as well as quiet time to relax, observe, and reflect upon the natural environment.

Children who complete this program receive a certificate, ribbon, and badge.

This year's theme: Habitat is Where it's at

Discover how Pennsylvania forest animals and plants survive and flourish in a wide variety of conditions.

Choose one camp session:

- Camp 8 June 26-28 9:00 AM-3:00 PM
- Camp 9 July 17-19 9:00 AM-3:00 PM
- Camp 10 July 31-Aug. 2 9:00 AM-3:00 PM

Fee: \$65
