Here are the stories of two families and the pets that needed treatment:

Parker is a beautiful Boxer mix. His family loved him and was able to give him basic care, but with a very low income, they could do nothing about a baseball-sized tumor hanging from his chest. They scraped up the money to take him to the vet only to be told the tumor, while benign, would continue to grow even larger. Thanks to Banfield, APSRC was able to pay for a portion of Parker's surgery. His family is so grateful and Parker is so much more comfortable and active.



Nellie is a senior citizen who is barely able to subsist on a small Social Security income. When both of her beloved elderly dogs became sick, she took them to the vet. She was told they needed x-rays and further testing because both dogs may have heart failure. Nellie didn't have the funds for further testing and was agonizing about having the dogs euthanized. Thanks to Banfield, APSRC was able to help Nellie get the dogs additional testing and receive the treatment they needed to remain comfortable.
