### VOLUNTEER INTEREST AREAS

- Adopt-a-trail: Looking for active trail users, to perform light maintenance on specific segments of trail (e.g., litter pick-up, trimming low branches and encroaching foliage, repair washouts after rain events) and report problem issues to park staff
- Trail Care Days: Rehabilitating and maintaining park trails on scheduled work days
- Assist with clerical work or data management for Friends of Pinchot
- Assist with education programs and/or events, or lead programs/activities (training provided). Activities may include nature walks, crafts, or potentially volunteer's area of expertise. Background Check is required
- Bird box monitoring (weekly during nesting season)
- Campground Host (contact park office @ 717-432-5011). Background Check is required
- Firewood sales, preparation and support (may include splitting, stacking and bundling of firewood)
- Fundraising, recruiting, and raising awareness (may include representing the Friends of Pinchot at public events)
- Habitat restoration and invasive species removal (training provided)
- Landscape design (incorporating knowledge of native plants, storm water management, sustainable practices)
- Plant and care for new native flower gardens, young trees, and native shrubbery
- Light construction/carpentry (e.g., nest boxes, benches, props for park programs). Designs and materials would be provided by the Friends of Pinchot, for volunteers to use their own tools/equipment
- Litter cleanup along lake's edge (kayak experience required)
- Staffing Environmental Learning Center, greeting visitors, providing park information, facilitating learning (3-4-hour shifts on weekends and holidays (training provided). Background check is required
