## Hiking & Biking

**Appalachian Trail**- White blazes  
uneven terrain, moderate

**Biker Hiker Trail**- Not blazed  
2 miles between Fuller and Laurel  
Lake; very easy, handicap accessible  
roadway shared use

**Pole Steeple Trail**-Blue blazes  
0.75 miles; uneven terrain, very steep

**Mountain Creek Trail**-Yellow blazes  
1.7 miles; uneven terrain, easy

**Swamp Trail**-Yellow blazes  
0.25 mile; uneven terrain, easy; access  
trail from Biker Hiker Trail

**Koppenhaver Trail**-Yellow blazes  
1 mile; uneven terrain, easy-moderate

**Brickyard Trail**-Yellow blazes  
0.3 mile; uneven terrain, easy

**Creek Trail**-Yellow blazes  
0.5 mile; uneven terrain, easy

**Biking is only permitted on the Biker  
Hiker Trail and roads in the park.**



## Fishing and Boating

### Stocked Fishing Waters

- Laurel Lake
- Fuller Lake
- Mountain Creek

### Fish for Free Days

- No fishing license needed
- Check the PA Fish & Boat website for dates

### Loan Equipment for Free

- Rods and tackle available when the park office is open
- Driver's license required



### Boating Only at Laurel Lake

- Boat rental open Memorial Day to Labor Day (cash only)
- PA boat registration needed for electric powered boats (use of gas motors prohibited)
- Launch permits needed for unpowered boats (sold in park office)

Follow all PA Fish & Boat regulations for fishing and boating.
