Training Choir I: This choir is for beginners, generally grades 1-2.

Rehearsals on Tuesday in Norfolk 6:43-5:30 p.m. OR Wednesday in Virginia Beach 6:43-5:30 p.m.

Training Choir II: This choir is for advancing beginners, generally grades 3-5.

Rehearsals on Tuesday in Norfolk 6:43-6:10 p.m. OR Wednesday in Virginia Beach 6:43-6:10 p.m.

Choristers: For intermediate music students, generally in grades 4-8.

Rehearsals on Tuesday in Norfolk 6:00-8:00 p.m. OR Wednesday in Virginia Beach 6:00-8:00 p.m.

Concert Choir: For advanced music students, generally in grades 7-10.

Rehearsals on Monday in Norfolk 6:50-7:30 6 solfège level 4 & 5

Rehearsals on Monday in Norfolk 6:53-8:00 6 solfège level 6 & 7

Chamber Singers: For older, advanced music students, generally girls grades 11-12 and high school aged boys with prior vocal training.

Rehearsals on Monday in Norfolk 6:00-8:30 p.m.

*The Music Directors will determine which choir is best for your level of skill, and where you will experience the most growth and enjoyment.

To Audition...

FIRST - Call the Chorus Manager at 440-9100 ext 3 to schedule your audition date and time and receive answers to your questions.

2. Audition Selection Requirements: If auditioning in the summer, this is the grade the student will be entering in September. All singing is unaccompanied. Only one verse of each song is required. In preparing for the audition, the student should practice the songs in the key and starting pitch comfortable for his/her voice. If needed, the director will give the student a suggested starting pitch at the audition.

Grades 1-3 for Group Try-Outs or Individual Audition (prepare one verse of all below)

- Twinkle, Twinkle Little Star
- Happy Birthday
- Mary Had a Little Lamb (verse 1)

Grades 4-5 (prepare one verse of all below)

- Happy Birthday
- My Country 'Tis of Thee
- Frere Jacques
- One other song of your choice 6 bring sheet music.

Grades 6-9 (prepare one verse of all below)

- The Star Spangled Banner
- Row, Row, Row Your Boat
- D Major Scale 6up & down on numbers (1-2-3f etc.)
- One other song of your choice 6 bring sheet music.

Grades 10-12 (prepare one verse of all below)

- Same as Grades 6-9 and
- Song of your choice should demonstrate singer's range and vocal technique (examples are a piece from your school or religious organization choir, classical song or Broadway show tune.) Bring sheet music.

3. Ask your music teacher for help in selecting the 6choice 6 piece for your audition and for help preparing for the required songs.

4. You should have the printed sheet music for your 6choice 6 piece. School, Church, Synagogue or youth organization music is appropriate for this audition.

5. Come to your scheduled audition. You will be informed at the audition if you have been accepted with the exception of Group Try-Outs for grades 1-3.

Please be prepared to pay a \$50 registration fee if student is accepted into the chorus. We will review registration materials at this time as well.

TUITION & FEES

2019-2020 Season

Annual Registration Fee.....\$50
New members pay upon acceptance into the Chorus and annually each year at re-registration. Includes first VCC t-shirt and \$5 Parent Association dues.

Uniform Fee.....\$60 - \$75
Varies with child's size and choir.

Ticket Fee Full / Spring.....\$50 / \$25
Each family receives 4 student-priced tickets to each of our two self-produced concerts.

Training Choir II.....3 payments of \$260.00

Choristers.....3 payments of \$276.65

Concert Choir.....3 payments of \$313.35

*Save installment fees of \$15 by paying in full at the start of the season.

*Spring enrollment rates also available. Spring semester families can pay 2 installments in January & March or in full in January.

*Financial aid and alternate monthly payment plans may be available. Call or e-mail for information and an application.

*Families with more than 1 child enrolled receive 15% discount off the lower tuition(s) after the first full price student and only pay one ticket fee.

Talbot Park Baptist Church
6919 Granby St., Norfolk, VA 23505

From I-64W: Take exit 277A, Tidewater Dr., South. At the very first light, Thole St., turn right. Go to the end of Thole St., and turn left on Granby St. Brackenridge Ave. is the second road once you are on Granby. Turn right and immediately left into the church parking lot.

From I-64E & the Peninsula: Exit 276 at Granby St., South. Go a mile down the road to Brackenridge Ave. on the right (just after the large, white Masonic Temple). Turn right and immediately left into the church parking lot.

From Downtown Norfolk: Take Tidewater Dr. north. At the 64 interchange on Tidewater, you will see Thole St., turn left. At the end of Thole Rd., turn left onto Granby St. Brackenridge Ave. is the second street on your right. Turn right and immediately left into the church parking lot.

For Everyone: Enter Talbot Park Baptist through the side door on Sinclair St., to your left when facing the building from Granby. On Sinclair St., follow the VCC audition signs to the set of three glass-paned doors to enter the church.
