



Scholarship Application for the 2018- 2019 Academic Year

Eligibility

Applicants to the Helen Gee Chin Scholarship Foundation Scholarship Program must:

- Be a U.S. citizen or Permanent Resident;
- Plan to enroll full-time as an undergraduate at an accredited U.S. four-year college or university for the entire 2018-2019 academic year;
- Have studied one or more of the Chinese Martial Arts – Kung Fu, Wu Shu, or Tai Chi – for a minimum of 5 [five] years; and
- Have a “B” average grade or better.

Award Criteria

Scholarship recipients are selected based on the following factors:

- Martial arts achievement (e.g., tournament medals*, contribution to the martial arts);
- Academic achievement;
- An essay explaining what the study of martial arts has meant to the applicant; and
- Participation and leadership in community and school activities, work experience, educational and career goals, and unusual circumstances.

Selection of recipients is made by the Trustees of the Helen Gee Chin Scholarship Foundation. Family members of the Trustees are ineligible for the award.

Award Amount

Awards are for undergraduate study only and pertain to a single academic year.

For the 2018-2019 academic year, the Helen Gee Chin Scholarship Foundation will make at least two awards of up to \$3000 each.

Recipient Code of Conduct

Recipients of a Helen Gee Chin Scholarship shall not commit any act that is dishonest, immoral, or illegal or that otherwise could hurt the image of the Chinese Martial Arts. If such an act is committed by a Helen Gee Chin Scholarship Program recipient, the Helen Gee Chin Scholarship award shall immediately be revoked.

* The expectation of tournament competition may be reduced in the case of special life circumstances (see Section 10).

Application Procedure

All application materials must be submitted by email or in writing **on or before June 15, 2018** (postmark date) to:

Applicants are responsible for submitting all materials on time and in **ONE ENVELOPE** (exception: official transcripts and letters may be mailed directly by their senders). The application may be downloaded and filled out electronically (www.hgcscholarshipfoundation.org). Incomplete applications will not be evaluated. Applications are complete and valid only when all of the following materials have been received:

Application Check List

- Application form
 - Complete official transcript(s), including grading scale, covering the last two years (from high school and/or college).
 - Essay explaining what the study of martial arts has meant in your life. (500 words or less)
 - A letter of recommendation from your current or most recent Sifu, attesting to your years of study and fitness for the scholarship
 - Recommendation from one other appropriate person (such as a teacher or counselor/advisor)
 - For high school seniors: rank, GPA, and test score information from school official (application section 11) and copy of college acceptance letter
- Be sure to copy the application for your records.***

Notification

All applicants will be notified by e-mail by mid-August 2018. At that time, the recipient must still be planning to enroll at the college listed in section 4 of the application form in 2018-2019.

Payment of Scholarships

Scholarships will be processed in one installment on August 15. Checks will be mailed to the recipient's home address and made payable to the school.
