The Center offers mentoring and tutoring programs for youth, computer training and access for youth and adults, employment training and job search assistance as well as assistance to those who are seeking to apply for public assistance such as food stamps, Medicaid, and other governmental programs.

The "B" Street Center currently serves as a beacon for the Northwest Lake Wales community. Various activities take place on regular daily, weekly, monthly and yearly basis at the center.

Several community groups including but not limited to the NAACP, Roosevelt Alumni, Unity in the Community, FL Department of Juvenile Justice, and FL Department of Children and Family Services, also use the facility for meetings and other functions.

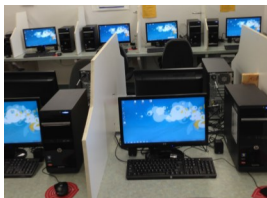
MISSION STATEMENT
