For the past 8 years or so, Spencer County Community Corrections has collaborated with The Way of Rockport as they have accepted numerous participants in our program as residents of their facility. We are able to keep close tabs on their status and progress through our mutual communications with Brett Cieslack, The Way Director. By offering a variety of programming, including Bible Study, Celebrate Recovery, Life Healing Choices (a faith based approach addressing addiction and recovery), Quit and Stay Quit (a tobacco cessation program), regular church attendance, and temporary housing, The Way meets many of the spiritual, personal and social needs of our clients.

Through a grant recently provided by The Way, our Community Corrections program has been able to purchase badly needed materials in support of the Preparation Classes for the High School Equivalency exam. In 2017, 42 young men and women participated with 29 earning their High School Equivalency Diploma.

As you can see, The Way has been an invaluable partner with Community Corrections and a critical resource for the homeless and downtrodden in our small rural community.
