Approval of minutes from May's PTA meeting: Approved as written

Treasurer report: Lori Coleman reported the account has \$14,460.91 as of today. Had a fund request for \$708.53 from Darcy Lamb for non fiction books for the Wolf Den. The school needs a lot more non-fiction books in order to conform to the Common Core standards. Motion to fund these books out of the "Author VIsit" funds, (as we are no longer having an author visit,) Erin Green. Seconded by Teresa Geer. Unanimous approval.

Linda Sundquist will research the cost on the plastic book covering to increase longevity of books purchased by the PTA and report back next month.

Unallocated funds now sits at \$3303.23

Fundraising report: Erin Green reported we had a successful Taco Time takeover. Have not yet received the check, but has been in contact and the check is expected to be about \$400.

Donna can have Darcy Lamb contact them and find out what it would cost and set it up, the PTA will pay as long as it's under \$200.00.

We have \$300 budgeted for a gift along with the salad bar for teachers. We had previously discussed splitting the cost of shirts with Donna Hudson. Donna is handling this and will get our half of the bill to Lori or Joelle. Plans for the week:
