Minutes for January approved as written

Treasurer's Report: Our current balance is \$34,534.27. We haven't been billed for cookie dough yet. Cookie dough raised \$27,939 and we get 40% of that, minus our portion of the prizes.

PTA Membership: We currently have 76 PTA Members. 100% of Greywolf teachers are now PTA Members. Uesenia Taylor won the gift card for membership.

Fundraising/New Business:

We are setting up a penny drive in the office for playground equipment. Sending home a flyer on Friday for the penny drive.

For businesses who donate over a certain amount of money for playground equipment will have their name on a plaque.

Rebecca has a list of grants specific for Clallam County.

Rebecca talked with the Sunrise Rotarians and they would love to help us install equipment.

The county will not help at all.

Box tops are due the 24th. We need volunteers to help count the Box Tops, because they need to be postmarked by March 1st.

Cookie dough is also being delivered on the 24th. There is no place to store cookie dough. It must be picked up after school on that day.

Math night is on February 25th. Dinner by donation is hot dogs, chili, and corn bread. We will put the penny drive jar out during Math Night.

February 26th is the Reptile Man. The assembly in the evening is \$1 per person.

Stacy has a takeover set up for Monday, March 7th at West Side Pizza and they are giving us 20%. They do not need people to bus tables or hold signs.

Black Bear Diner is also willing to donate a percentage for a takeover, but the details are still being worked out.

Mariner's tickets fundraiser- We would buy tickets at a discounted rate, we can sell them for as much as we want up to face value. We presell and only get charged for what we sell. We are thinking of selling them in the beginning of April.

Nomination committee- We need nominations for next year's PTA President and VP of enrichment.

Robin Forrest put in an application for funds request for \$100. Stacy motioned to approve that Robin Forrest receive \$100 and Rebecca seconded it. Motion was approved by unanimous decision.

Discussion about Carrie Art and whether or not it is worth it to continue. Monique shared feedback from teachers. Everyone who returned the feedback form stated that they enjoy Carrie Art. Dede and Rebecca stated we should look for art grants.

Delia wanted to know if we've ever considered Spirit Week (end of March) to bolster fundraisers. There was discussion about a sports themed spirit week to bolster Mariner ticket sales. Dede was going to talk to Donna about the possibility.
