Old Business:

Treasurer's Report: Current balance is \$20,907.34. Beginning balance for October was \$7,698.96 and ending balance was \$20,247.77.

Bazaar update: It's brought in \$3210 in income with only 3 spots left in gym. This year, there is a photographer who will donate 20% of all sales to the PTA.

Candy for the Troops: See Asta's attached report.

Still looking for a volunteer coordinator: The middle school uses Sign-Up Genius; we will try the free version for Math night with the teachers and see if it works for PTA.

Box Tops: Nicole turned in box tops and not one was rejected. Total collected for box tops is \$798.30.

New Business:

Drama Club: Sheri Burke requests on behalf of the drama club \$600 to buy the rights to a musical. This is the last time they will ask for a show kit as they now have enough plays to recycle through so kids don't have to repeat the same plays. Donations pay for props, costumes, and paint. 2 shows will be performed: 1 dress rehearsal for the whole school & a Fri and Sat show. 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade can try out and this year there will be auditions. Stephanie Clark motioned to approve the expenditure, and Stacy Campbell seconded. Unanimous vote.

Weatherbug: KING 5 news contacted us to say that the weatherbug is not working and requires a \$300 humidity controller to fix it. Tricia is going to find out the total cost. We will explore other options to pay for this other than PTA money.

Pencil Sharpener Request: The teachers would like \$304.97 for 2 pencil sharpeners and 4 sharpener parts to be replaced. Sheri Burke motions, and Linda Sundquist seconds the motion.

Free Money: The PTA needs to step up its advertising about shoparoo, smile.Amazon, and Boxtops. This is free money for us. Rebecca will advertise it more on Facebook.

Book Fair: Dena needs \$200 for the book fair till and \$100 for the Bazaar raffle. Tricia will take care of this.

Carrie Art: One of the teachers has applied for a Beta Nu grant; we'll know by the next meeting if the school's been approved. Tricia will talk with Carrie to see about reducing the cost of supplies by using what we already have purchased.
