Old Business:

Treasurer's Report: As of 10/17, beginning balance was \$7,698.96. Ending balance is \$21,164.99. PTA membership brought in \$520, Jog-a-thon earned \$12,672.03, Spirit Wear earned \$400, and the Bazaar has earned \$1345. The Jog-a-thon cost \$30.

Bazaar Update: Greywolf Bazaar is November 19th and 20th and there are about 10 total spots left available.

Candy for Troops: FedEx will donate the cost of shipping, and the Girl Scouts will collect the candy. Tricia will consult with Donna about allergy concerns of candy in boxes in the hallway.

New Business:

Time of Meetings: moved back to 3:30pm because it's already been published on the district calendar that way.

Jog-a-thon: The fundraiser raised over \$12,000, which exceeded our goal.

Checks for teachers: Teresa made a motion and Dede seconded it to pay each teacher \$100 for classroom supplies, for a total of \$3,000.

Communication chair: We will get rid of the PTA website and funnel all traffic to the PTA Facebook page. Rebecca will allow staff at the school access to the Facebook page so that announcements can also come from the school to the Facebook audience.

Carrie Art: The current art program costs \$3,000, and supplies 2 art lessons a year per class. Kim reported from survey monkey that she made, that most teachers would like to continue with art lessons. We need more information regarding art curriculum, costs, and what the teachers would like to do. We will table this discussion for a few months while we gather information.

Volunteer Coordinator: The PTA needs a volunteer coordinator right away!

Book Fair: During parent/teacher conference week, Nov. 14th-20th, Dena needs volunteers to help with the book fair. Only PTA members can handle cash, but any volunteers can help children find books.

Yearbook: Kim will be in charge of yearbooks, and Angela will help.

Restaurant Takeovers: We will not pursue restaurant takeovers until the New Year.
