The Scotch Plains-Fanwood Scholarship Foundation continues its 52-year old tradition of assisting graduating seniors and current college students who reside in Scotch Plains and Fanwood in achieving their goal of a college or other post-high school education. Since its inception, the Foundation has proudly awarded \$3,070,977 to 2,948 local students. This past June, \$145,500 was awarded to 93 students from our joint communities.

As a prospective applicant, please carefully review the description of each scholarship listed in this booklet. You will find:

- Only **one** application needs to be completed to be considered for most scholarships listed.
- There are both financial need and non-financial need-based scholarships.
 - o Graduating seniors can apply for both need and non-need scholarships.
 - Current college students are eligible for need-based scholarships only.
 - Need-based scholarship applicants must complete the *Income Verification Worksheet* and supply the necessary supporting tax documents.
- Several scholarships require an additional letter of recommendation or an essay which must be submitted along with your application.
- Deadline for submitting the application and all supporting documents is FEBRUARY 15, 2018. Applications will be accepted beginning January 1, 2018. Early submission is encouraged. Applications accessed at www.spfscholarshipfoundation.org can be filled in online, but must be printed and mailed as directed.

Please read the 2018 Scholarships booklet thoroughly as answers to most questions are contained within the booklet. If additional questions should arise, please do not hesitate to contact the Scholarship Foundation at spfscholarshipfoundation@gmail.com or visit our website.

INSTRUCTIONS

Scotch Plains and Fanwood residents who are graduating seniors from public or private high schools or current college students who plan to attend a post-high school institution in the fall of 2018 may apply for scholarship assistance. Recognized post-high school institutions include two and four-year colleges, technical and vocational schools within the United States. Applications accessed at www.spfscholarshipfoundation.org can be filled in online, but must be printed and mailed as directed below.

Each applicant will be considered for all scholarships administered by the Scotch Plains-Fanwood Scholarship Foundation based on individual scholarship criteria and eligibility. Applications are reviewed by a Screening Committee comprised of at least four Trustees from the Scholarship Foundation, a PTA representative from each of the eight local schools and a PTA Council representative.

In addition to your completed 2018 Application, please submit the following supporting documents by February 15th:

- 1. A personal letter explaining:
 - A. Reasons for requesting scholarship assistance
 - B. Goals and plans for the future
 - C. Interests and activities that you feel are significant in your life
 - D. Employment experience, including the use of earnings
 If employment is through your family owned business, indicate whether compensation is received.
 - E. Any extenuating family circumstances or information (illness, expenses, job loss, etc.)
- 2. One letter of reference (all applicants)
 - One letter from a teacher, professor, employer or other significant adult (excluding relatives) should be mailed **directly** by the person selected to the address below. Letters must be postmarked by February 15th.
- 3. <u>An official high school transcript including SAT and/or ACT scores</u> (high school applicants only) You are responsible for requesting your official high school transcript and SAT/ACT scores be sent directly by your high school to the address below. SPFHS applicants should use the *Parent/Guardian Authorization for Release of Transcripts* form located in the back of the booklet.
- 4. An official college transcript (college applicants only)

You are responsible for requesting your official college transcript be sent **directly** by your school to the address below. **Transcripts must be postmarked by February 15**th. Internet downloaded transcripts will not be accepted.

Incomplete or unsigned applications may not be considered. All pages of the application must be submitted, please do not staple. Do not include pictures or additional materials in support of your application.

SCHOLARSHIPS

The following is a listing of all scholarships administered by the Scotch Plains-Fanwood Scholarship Foundation including dollar amounts for each award and individual scholarship criteria. Scholarships are grouped alphabetically by **Financial Need** or **Non-Financial Need-based** consideration. Please note that several scholarships have an additional essay or letter of recommendation required. The Class of 1960 Memorial Scholarship requires a different application. All essays must be submitted with the application.

For scholarships including "Foundation requirements" as a criterion, an applicant must exhibit ALL of the following:

- 1. Financial need Financial Need Verification Worksheet and income documentation must be submitted (application page 6).
- Character
- 3. Academic scholarship
- 4. Evidence of financial self-help Requires both employment and a financial contribution toward college expenses by the applicant.
- 5. School and/or community service

College applicants are only eligible for the Dollars for Students scholarships, which are **Financial Need-based** scholarships and require applicants to satisfy all of the Foundation requirements.

FRANK DINIZO MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (established 2011)

One \$500 award for a SPFHS graduating senior exhibiting outstanding community service; Foundation requirements

DOLLARS FOR STUDENTS SCHOLARSHIPS (established 1966)

A total of \$23,000 was given in 2017 to 17 graduating seniors and current college students; Foundation requirements

ROBERT H. KRAUS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (established 2010)

One \$2,000 award for a SPFHS graduating senior attending Rutgers, extra-curricular activities or volunteerism, 3.0 GPA, financial need

One \$2,000 award for a SPFHS graduating senior majoring in nursing; Foundation requirements

ETHEL PERKINS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (Rotary-Garbe; established 2010)

One \$2,000 award for four years for a graduating senior pursuing a degree from an accredited college, financial need

JAMES O'HARA POWERS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS (established 1998)

Two \$1,000 awards for a male and a female SPFHS graduating senior achieving a varsity letter, exhibiting team dedication and enthusiasm, financial need

DR. MURIEL H. RAMSDEN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (established 1991)

One \$1,500 award for a female SPFHS graduating senior majoring in science, preference to chemistry; Foundation requirements

TERRY AND ARLENE RIEGEL SCHOLARSHIP (established 2013)

One \$2,500 award for a SPFHS graduating senior exhibiting potential and promise for success in college; Foundation requirements

ROTARY-GARBE FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS (established 1987)

Three \$2,000 awards for four years for graduating seniors from SPFHS, Union Catholic or any school within the UCVTS system exhibiting high moral character, leadership qualities, successful academic capabilities, planning to attend college or vocational school, financial need

DR. ROBERT V. SCALERA SCHOLARSHIP (established 2010)

One \$1,000 award for a SPFHS graduating senior pursuing a health-related profession, community service, financial need

SCHOOL ONE RETIRED ELEMENTARY EDUCATORS AND STAFF (established 2014)

One \$500 award for a graduating senior who attended School One, exhibiting potential for success, financial need

JAMES R. SOCHAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (established 2002)

One \$500 award for a SPFHS graduating senior, financial need

FRANKLIN MAINE AND HELEN McCONNELL SPOONER SCHOLARSHIP (established 2002)

One \$2,000 award for a female SPFHS graduating senior majoring in biology, botany, chemistry, physics or engineering; Foundation requirements

JEFFREY SPRING MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (established 1995)

One award for a SPFHS or Union Catholic graduating senior exhibiting motivation and progress, academic excellence, involvement in school activities, financial need. Final 2018 award amount announced in the spring

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THE CLASS OF 1960 MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (established 2017) * * Requires a different application * *

One four-year award for a SPFHS graduating senior attending Rutgers University. Award covers the complete cost of on-campus room and board and fees (approx. value \$15,000 per year). Upon graduation from Rutgers University an additional amount equal to the 4th year payment will be awarded. 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NON-FINANCIAL NEED-BASED SCHOLARSHIPS:

ADRIAN ANDREWS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (established 2013)

One \$1,500 award for a SPFHS graduating senior exhibiting academic scholarship, character, school and/or community service; requires an essay describing how a specific friendship has impacted your life

JIM ALFANO MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (established 2012)

One \$1,500 award for a SPFHS graduating senior participating in track, who exhibits good sportsmanship, leads by example, shows respect for fellow teammates and coaches and puts forth consistent effort

CHARLIE BROWN'S FRESH GRILL SCHOLARSHIP (established 2014)

One \$1,500 award for a SPFHS graduating senior exhibiting academic scholarship, character, school and/or community service; preference given to a major in restaurant/hotel management, nutritional science or business

MAURO AND RULENE DIFRANCESCO SAINT BARTHOLOMEW'S GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP (established 2017)

One \$1,500 award for a SPFHS graduating senior who is a graduate from Saint Bartholomew's Academy, exhibiting potential for success

<u>CAMILLE DINIZO MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP</u> (established 2017)

One \$1,000 award for a SPFHS graduating senior exhibiting potential for success, character, school and/or community service, evidence of financial self-help, majoring in education with preference given to special education; requires a one-page essay describing your experience with children, your motivation for entering the teaching profession and if applicable, your reasons for choosing to work with Special Needs students

DONNA J. DOREMUS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (established 2008)

One \$500 award for a SPFHS graduating senior preferably active in Relay for Life and/or SMAC, attending a four-year college or university; requires a maximum 2-page essay describing your 4 years at SPFHS and a unique experience that made a key difference in your life

KAREN AND JOSEPH FRANZONE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (established 2001)

One \$1,000 award for a graduating senior majoring in education at a four-year college with preference given to special education, may have overcome a learning disability

FRIDAY'S PLACE SCHOLARSHIP (established 2001)

One \$1,000 award for a well-rounded graduating senior exhibiting academic success, community service

FRANK FUMOSA MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (established 2017)

One \$1,500 award for a SPFHS graduating senior exhibiting academic scholarship, character, school and/or community service, must show evidence of financial self-help; first preference given to an outstanding percussionist majoring in music with secondary preference given to a 4-year participant in the instrumental music program

GIRL SCOUT SCHOLARSHIP (established 2011)

One \$500 award for a female graduating senior currently a registered Girl Scout, active in F-SP Girl Scouts for the last 5 years, exhibiting academic scholarship, character, school and/or community service; requires an essay describing how Girl Scouts has assisted you in student life and prepared you for adulthood

GORDON MEMORIAL LACROSSE SCHOLARSHIPS (established 2013)

Two \$1,000 awards for a male and a female graduating SPFHS senior who is a member of the lacrosse team, academic scholarship, character, school and/or community service

DORIS KOUES MEMORIAL NURSING SCHOLARSHIP (established 1995)

One \$400 award for a graduating senior entering the field of nursing

WILLIAM AND RUTH LINGE SCHOLARSHIPS (established 2006)

Two awards for a male and a female SPFHS graduating senior excelling in a foreign language; requires an additional letter of recommendation mailed directly from a foreign language instructor. Final 2018 award amounts announced in the spring

JOHN AND MARIE LOSAVIO MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (established 1999)

One \$500 award for a graduating senior majoring in music, exhibiting good character and a good scholastic record

COURTNEY E. METZGER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (established 2000)

One or more awards totaling \$2,500 for a female(s) SPFHS graduating senior participating in athletics during high school; requires an essay describing yourself as an individual

TOM MONTAGNA (FOLLOW YOUR DREAM) SCHOLARSHIP (established 2014)

One \$1,000 award for a SPFHS graduating senior exhibiting academic scholarship, character, school and/or community service; preference given to a member of the SPFHS golf team, but participation in student government, business, dance or music also considered; requires a one-page essay sharing your dream for the future and plans for achieving that dream

WILLIAM MULLIN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (Rotary-Garbe; established 2010)

One \$2,000 award for four years for a graduating senior majoring in animal science or veterinary medicine at an accredited college

KATHERINE NEWCOMER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (established 2016)

One \$1,500 award for a SPFHS graduating senior exhibiting academic scholarship, character, school and/or community service; first preference given to a nursing major with secondary preference to the healthcare field

LYNN PAYNE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (established 2016)

One award for a graduating senior exhibiting academic potential, character, school and/or community service, evidence of financial self-help, striving to enhance the lives of others; requires a one-page essay describing the person who inspired you to want to change or make better the lives of others and how you worked or continue to work to achieve this goal; preference given to a degree in social/human services including but not limited to social work, counseling or medicine. 2018 award amount announced in the spring

LaVERNE SCHNELL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (established 2017)

One \$1,500 award for a SPFHS graduating senior exhibiting school and/or community service, financial self-help; preference given to a fashion design, fashion marketing or graphic arts major

SCOTCH PLAINS-FANWOOD ICE HOCKEY ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP (established 2015)

One \$1,000 award for a graduating senior who is a member of the ice hockey team
