Here is how it works:

- Complete the application below
- Deadline is February 12, 2016
- Send the completed application to Sandy McCauley at gwlqueen@frontiernet.net
- Recipients will be notified by March 12, 2016
- When the Educational Foundation receives notification from the NAEOP Office that you are registered for conference and pre-paid, you will be sent a verification form
- When you attend your Institute or Briefing in July, introduce yourself to the presenter and give the verification form to him/her. At the conclusion of the session, get the presenter's signature on the form as proof of your attendance
- All verification forms must be returned to Foundation Trustee, Sandy McCauley, at the conference or mailed to 276 Burnt Mill Road, Churchville, NY 14428
- When you have successfully completed this process, the NAEOP Office will then be notified to send you a check for the reimbursement
