Earn rolls of toilet tissue from complete sections and make your leader into a snowman.

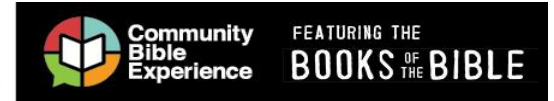

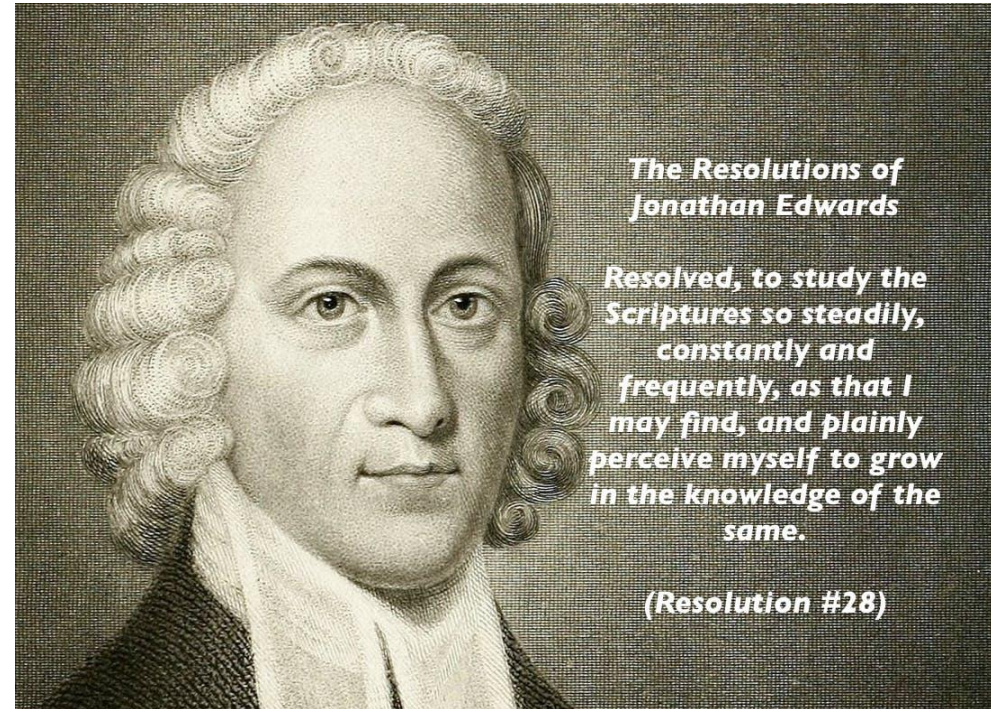
