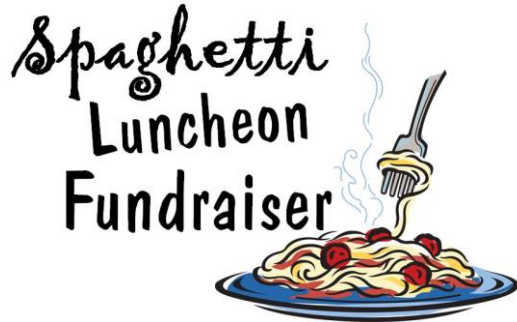
Community Bible Experience-The Prophets – This week you should be reading Jeremiah 26–52.

Twenty-seven times in this most Jewish of the gospels, we read of our Savior's great compassion for the multitudes that followed Him, "weary, scattered like sheep having no shepherd" (Matthew 9:36). These were the multitudes that Jesus taught and healed, and for whom He would suffer and die. This sermon presentation gives snapshots from Jesus's life and ministry, following His pilgrimage from Bethlehem to the empty tomb.
