On Thursday evening, March 22, we are **not** having the Easter Seder meal, but we are having Alexander Adelson from Jews for Jesus with us. Some of you may remember Alex from two years ago when he spoke. This year Alex will be presenting:

Multitudes: The Messiah and the Jewish People

"Multitudes" presents a pictorial journey through the Messiah's life and ministry featuring a collection of specially-commissioned paintings of scenes from the gospel of Matthew. Twenty-seven times in this most Jewish of the gospels, we read of our Savior's great compassion for the multitudes that followed Him, "weary, scattered like sheep having no shepherd" (Matthew 9:36). These were the multitudes that Jesus taught and healed, and for whom He would suffer and die. This sermonic presentation gives snapshots from Jesus's life and ministry, following His pilgrimage from Bethlehem to the empty tomb.
