



RIDGEVUE WARHAWKS GIRLS SOCCER RULES 2017

Academics:

1. This is and should be your priority. Put the time into your school work, listen to your teachers, and pass your classes. Don't skip classes, don't fail your classes, and most importantly ask for help when needed. Practice start time will be at 4:00 (once school starts).
2. If you are struggling in class, seek assistance, tutoring, ask a teammate for help, attend Warhawk Workshop, talk to a teacher or talk to a counselor for additional support.
3. If sports become a distraction, focus on your education, talk to your coaches. Having an F in class will make you ineligible to play in games. If you remain ineligible to participate in soccer because of your grades for 4 games throughout the season, you will be dismissed from the program so that you can focus on your education.

Practices & Games:

1. All student/athletes must attend a minimum of 10 practices prior to being eligible to participate in their first game. No Exceptions.
2. Tardiness will not be tolerated. If a student will be late, coaches must be notified. Excessive tardiness to games/practices can result in game suspensions, up to including dismissal.
3. If a student/athletes will be absent they must make arrangements with the coach. Unexcused absences are unacceptable and can result in suspension and up to dismissal.
4. If your daughter is sick, a doctor's note is required. If no note is provided the absence will be unexcused. School related events will be excused. Other absences will be reviewed on a case by case basis, although most will be unexcused (i.e. needing to babysit, not having a ride, vacations, those will not be excused). The season has started already.
5. Away games: All student/athlete will ride the bus to and from away games. If a student/athletes must leave, arrangements must be made with the coach 24 hours ahead of time. Those players must still be signed out.
6. Home games: All student/athletes will be in attendance for both JV and varsity games
7. Playing time is not guaranteed. This will be based off of skill level, attitude, coachability, effort, and eligibility.

Equipment & Uniforms:

1. Student/athletes and parents understand that all uniforms are property of Ridgevue High School. Student/athletes understand that they are financially responsible for any loss or damage to any equipment or uniforms.



Lettering:

1. To receive a varsity letter, student/athletes must meet the following conditions.
 - a. Successfully finish the season
 - b. Be in good academic standings
 - c. Play in a minimum of 16 halves on the varsity team throughout the season
 - d. Must be in attendance at the end of season banquet to receive your varsity letter
 - e. Must have all uniform and equipment turned in on the day that it is due

Conduct:

All student/athletes are expected to act in accordance with the Ridgevue student code of conduct. Any violation can result in a suspension including up to dismissal from the team. This includes conduct off the field and is not limited to behavior on social media, bullying, cyberbullying, drugs/alcohol use, or anything else that may be seen as detrimental to the team.

Last but not least, be respectful. Respect your teammates, your coaches, the refs, and most importantly your opponents. This includes parents and spectators.

Coaches Availability:

Coaches will be available to meet with any parents after any practices. Please make arrangements to meet with coaches if possible. If there are any concern coaching structure, anything related to the team that you may have a concern with, feel free to contact us either via email, text, or in person.

Also, please note that coaches will not be available to meet with parents to discuss any concerns immediately before or after a game.
