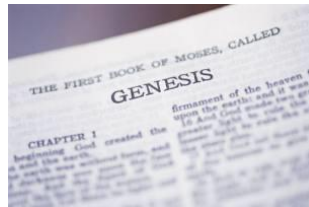
Youth: Grades 7-12
